- Lead/teach group activities (after training) including, but not limited to: archery, arts/crafts, horses, ropes, drama, sports and canoes.
- Live/sleep in dorm with campers and staff.
- Provide spiritual leadership to campers.
- Care for the health, safety, and spiritual welfare of all campers in your room group at all times.
- Participate with campers in all activities while being encouraging & enthusiastic.
- Conduct devotions each night with your campers.
- Pray daily for each camper.
- Be present and on time for all counselor meetings and events.
